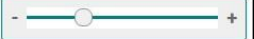

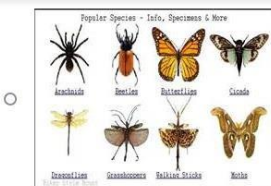

Acid rain results from the release into the atmosphere of sulphur oxide and nitrogen oxide. Electrical generating plants, industrial boilers, large smelters, and automobiles are among the chief source of these emissions. How did the universe begin, and when? These questions have puzzled men for countless years. Present-day theories fall into two classes-evolutionary and steady-state.

The Belgian George Lemaitre put forward the idea that about 20,000 million years ago all the matter in the universe-enough, he estimated, to make up a hundred thousand million galaxies-was all concentrated in one small mass, which he called the 'primeval atom'. This primeval atom exploded for some reason, sending its matter out in all directions, and as the expansion slowed down, a steady state resulted, at which time the galaxies formed. Something then upset the balance and the universe started expanding again, and this is the state in which the universe is now. There are variations on this theory: it may be that there was no steady state. However, basically, evolutionary theories take it that the universe was formed in one place at one point in time and has been expanding ever since.
